Property Tax Notices

Property tax notices will be mailed during the first week of May 2026, with payment due by June 30, 2026. Please ensure payment is submitted by the due date to avoid penalties.

On May 12, the Town crew will receive water from the Magrath Irrigation District and initiate the irrigation turn on process by filling our main lines.

On May 19th, crews will start gradually opening lines section by section to check for any winter-related breaks. This procedure takes around 2 weeks depending on the extent of repairs required.

Please refrain from turning on any Town valves, as this could lead to flooding and other issues. You may occasionally check your standpipe for water flow.

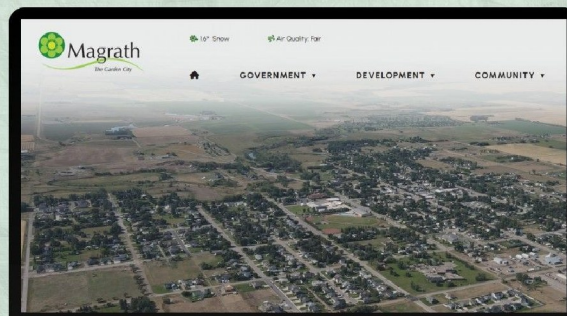
